MEET OUR TOP 10

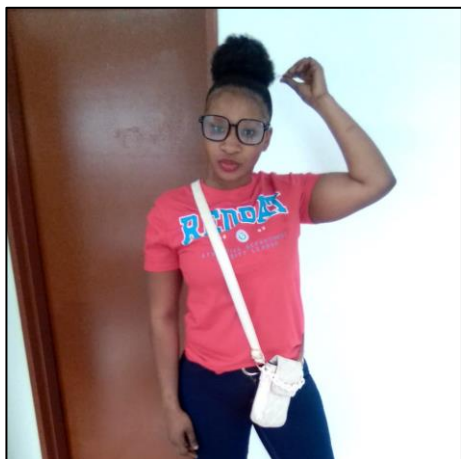
